GROVE PARK GRILL POLICY

Updated September 2018

No grills, firepits, smokers, etc of any kind are allowed anywhere other than the common grills provided in the common areas. This is due to fire codes and regulations and will be strictly enforced.

Note from 10/19:

Fire Marshall considers any high-temperature cooking device to be an open-flame device. Smokers, for instance, are the same as a grill. The smoker must be opened to place food on/off the smoker, at which time it's open-flame therefore. Same for fire-pits. The Fire Marshall considers these to be open-flame fire hazards (ISC Code). The COA is entitled to, and does, set a higher standard than the ISC Code to protect the collective investment and residents of said investment. City of Milledgeville Fire Marshall 478-414-4029
